### FROM THE DIRECTOR OF MISSIONS

Almost a decade ago, I wanted to hike to Mount LeConte by myself, and thought there was no better time than my 50th birthday. Maybe I thought it would make me feel younger to know that I could do it. Rain forced the postponement of the journey a few days, but I was determined. Tracy wasn't keen on the idea of me going by myself, but Alum Cave Trail is usually well populated. But not on this cold but clear February day, as I immediately discovered when I got to the parking lot where there were only a few cars.

No trouble making it to the caves on the lower end of the trail. I only passed one couple but otherwise was alone. Someone had erroneously told me that past the caves the journey was easy. Maybe it is in summer, but on this day ice covered much of the trail. It was slow going. Carefully looking for dry spots on the rocks among the ice, or at times clinging to the cables drilled into the rocks for safety. All the while remembering that I was alone. One slip causing any kind of injury and I might be in trouble.

I held out the thought that once at the top I could refresh myself by a warm fire while eating lunch. I knew the cabins were closed, but thought the caretaker would be waiting on me. He wasn't. There was nothing open, everything was locked. I was alone on Mount LeConte. Knowing that the same ice awaited me on the trip down, and still thinking in the back of my mind that one fall could be troublesome, I didn't waste any time. I was only at the top for a few minutes, didn't even take the time to eat, just headed back down.

I was relieved to pass several other people shortly after I began my descent. Now I knew that if I did fall, someone would be along behind me in twenty or thirty minutes. As I stepped aside to let another couple by the man asked, "How was the view at the top? I bet it's beautiful." I lied and said it was, and went on my way. The truth was I hadn't even taken the time to look. I was so concerned with getting back down safely I hadn't enjoyed the moment.

Five plus hours of hiking and I had rushed right through the summit. His question and my inability to answer haunted me the rest of the hike. Why was I so concerned with the accomplishment that I missed the journey itself? The greater question became, was this just an issue of the day or indicative of my life?

I say all of that to say, don't miss the journey. Enjoy the moments because they go by so fast. Yes, there is a lot of hard work and effort expended in life and ministry, but don't miss the joy along the way. Take time to see the beauty around you. You'll be glad you did.


